TASTING NOTES

An impossibly dark extracted color, almost black. The nose is explosive with aromas of cassis, earth, plum, and leather combining for a distinctive experience. The mouthfeel is incredibly full and the palate absorbs overt flavors of black ripe fruit. An earthiness dominates the array of flavors. Simply a giant wine. Serve with rich food and exotic spices. Drink now through 2030.

VINTAGE NOTES

One of the rare vintages where the weather cooperated and we were able to harvest all of the fruit when we wanted to instead of being pressured by impending adverse weather. Tremendous wine quality across all of the wines with very few problematic fermentations. Chemistry (pH, TA, sugars) were consistently in the proper ranges and the resulting wines are very ageable with excellent tannin structure.
